SURFACE PREP

BARE METAL: Remove all rust scale with wire brush or sander. Remove oil and grease. Prime with Majic Tractor, Truck & Auto Acrylic Gray Primer. PAINTED METAL: Remove loose or peeling paint and rust scale with wire brush or sander. Remove oil and grease. Prime any bare metal. PAINTED SURFACES: (General) Make sure surface is clean, dry, free of loose paint, direct, wax, grease, etc. Sand glossy areas. Rinse surface thoroughly with fresh water and allow to fully dry. All surfaces must be dry at time of application.

APPLICATION

Stir thoroughly. Apply with a high quality brush or by spray equipment at a film thickness of 2 mil. Where necessary apply a second coat and allow each coat to dry thoroughly before applying the next coat. Do not apply if air or suface temperature is below 50° F or above 95° F or in direct sunlight. Do not apply to hot surfaces above 200° F. The relative humidity should not be greater than 85%. Extremely high or low relative humidity can effect dry time and the final gloss of the coating. On unpainted surfaces, apply two coats for best result, sanding lightly between coats. To spray, reduce with 5-10% of fresh clean water by volume as needed. Allow at least 24 hours after the final coat, before subjecting equipment to heavy use.
