

BOWL CLEANER

BOWL CLEANER is a concentrated acid/detergent emulsion used for cleaning, descaling and deodorizing of sanitary washroom facilities.

USES:	To clean and maintain urinals, toilet bowls and waste pipes. BOWL CLEANER may be used advantageously in septic tank systems.
PROPERTIES:	 BOWL CLEANER penetrates hard scale normally deposited on the surface of porcelain urinals and toilet bowls, dissolves it instantly and allows it to be flushed in a soluble state down the waste pipe. The use of the emulsion form helps it to "stick" to the walls of the fixture long enough for the chemical reaction to take place. Ordinary deliming solutions run straight off the smooth porcelain surface making several applications necessary to do a satisfactory job in spite of adequate adhesive properties. BOWL CLEANER rapidly 'wets' into deposited scale and operates with maximum activity between the lower surface of the scale and the porcelain walls of the fixture. Solution run-off delivers residual action deep down in waste pipes and traps, ensuring trouble-free plumbing and freedom from odour. BOWL CLEANER contains powerful disinfectant properties with extended residual action sufficient to destroy bacteria for many days after each treatment.
DIRECTIONS:	<u>URINALS – INITIAL CLEANING</u> Remove grating and pour BOWL CLEANER generously over a cotton swab allowing excess fluid to run down into trap. Swab surface of porcelain making very sure that concealed areas behind rims, etc. are reached. Repeat this operation until the whole fixture is thoroughly cleaned.

DIRECTIONS CONT'D:	<u>URINALS – INITIAL CLEANING CONT'D.</u> Now use urinal brush to speed reaction in the wastepipe. Add more BOWL CLEANER if necessary to complete final removal of all visible scale. Unspent cleaner running through the pipes will have cleared inaccessible traps at the same time. Replace grating and rinse.
	<u>URINALS – ROUTINE CLEANING</u> Thoroughly wet swab with BOWL CLEANER and apply liberally over the whole surface of the porcelain fixture. Allow to sit 5 – 20 seconds, then wipe lightly with swab to remove loose scale, then flush clean. Routine cleaning should be carried out daily; procedure for "Initial Cleaning" should subsequently be carried out every three months or more frequently in hard water areas.
	<u>TOILET BOWLS</u> Pour a little BOWL CLEANER into the bowl allowing it to flow over the surface of the fixture, particularly under rims. Finally, swish water still lying in bowl, inspect rims and rinse.
PRECAUTIONS:	EYE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED. Rubber gloves are not usually considered necessary when using BOWL CLEANER except by operators with a record of sensitive skin. Direct contact will cause a slight stinging sensation and the hands should be rinsed.
PACKAGING:	4 X 4 litre polyethylene bottles 12 X 1 litre cases Containers are lightweight and unbreakable.
