It provides a watertight, weatherproof and fast drying seal against air and moisture, keeping homes warmer in winter, cooler in summer, while also reducing energy bills. Use it to seal drafty windows, seasonally used doors, around air conditioners, vents or fans. Then easily peel it away when no longer needed. Interior and exterior use.

Surface Preparation & Application:

- 1. Remove any loose or foreign material.
- 2. Clean & dry surface. The surfaces must be free of creosote, oil, grease, wax, silicone, silicone-based product, asphalt or bitumen-based product, and any material soluble in solvents.
- **3.** Trim nozzle to desired bead size. Cut the nozzle at a right angle (90°) slightly narrower than the width of the gap.
- 4. Puncture inner foil seal.
- 5. Load cartridge into caulking gun.
- 6. Fill gaps with sealant. Large gaps may require several layers.
- 7. Do not shape or tool the bead.
- 8. Peel away excess sealant when dry. Product left in place for more than one year may be more difficult to remove, Product may peel or damage wallpaper, uncured or degraded coatings.

DO NOT SEAL FIRE EXITS. CONSULT LOCAL FIRE OR CODE OFFICIAL WITH QUESTIONS ABOUT FIRE EXITS.

THIS PRODUCT HAS A VERY STRONG ODOR. ENSURE PROPER VENTILATION IS USED WHEN PRODUCT IS APPLIED AND CURING.

FOR BEST RESULTS:

- Apply in temperatures above 40°F.
- Store below 80°F in a cool, dry place away from extreme heat or cold.
- Not for continuous underwater use.
- Do not use on freshly painted surfaces. Product may peel or damage wallpaper, uncured or degraded coatings.
- Do not use on insulating panels or plastic materials which can be damaged by solvents.
- New metal and solvent resistant oily surfaces must be washed with acetone and dried.
- For unusual substrates, perform a test for adhesion prior to use.
- For gaps wider than ¹/₄", backer rod should be used.
- The sealant should come into contact with each of the surfaces on a width of at least 1/8".
- If applied indoors, the area must be ventilated during application and drying time.
