

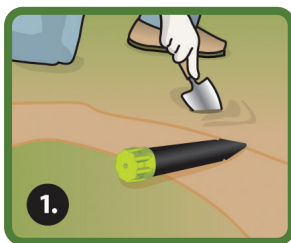


MOLE+ GOPHER SONIC SPIKE II REPELLERS

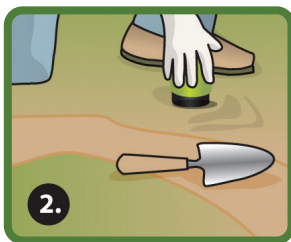
Location

Identify active tunnels. Raised tunnels and/or fresh soil mounds indicate active tunnels. Place the Sonic Spike Repellers close to structures. Move Repellers once a week, towards perimeter of affected area, until pests have retreated. Additional Repellers may be required, depending on size and shape of affected area.

Placement



Make a pilot hole (using a trowel, transplanter or wooden stake) in the ground before inserting sonic spike.



DO NOT HAMMER or use EXCESSIVE FORCE when inserting the spike. Push Spike straight down to avoid damage.



Insert spike keeping solar panel above ground level. Tamp soil around the spike to ensure a firm fit.



Operating Instructions:

- Open the spike by turning the cap counter-clockwise until removed.
- Insert **3 D-Cell Batteries** into battery sleeve as indicated. Slide Sleeve into spike chamber.
- Replace the cap and tighten securely to ensure protection from moisture and humidity.
- When batteries are properly installed, you will hear a buzzing sound for 2-3 seconds every 25-27 seconds
- Batteries will last up to 3 months depending on environmental conditions. To replace batteries, simply remove the spike from the ground, loosen the cap and replace into the Sleeve as needed.
