# POTTING SOIL

### • USE STRAIGHT FROM THE BAG

This blend of organic materials needs no additives and does not require pre-moistening. It provides a firm yet workable medium for supporting plants.

### • GENERAL PURPOSE POTTING SOIL

Good for potting all types of potted plants. For best results when starting seeds, use a mix specifically formulated for seed starting, such as Scotts® or Miracle-Gro® Seed Starting.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when using this and other planting materials.

### WHEN TO REPOT

Your plant probably needs reporting if roots are growing out of the drainage holes, bottom leaves turn yellow and drop off, or the plant wilts between normal waterings.

### POTTING AND REPOTTING

- It is important to use a pot with drainage holes. If repotting, select the next size larger than the current pot. If establishing a container garden, select a pot large enough to accommodate the plant(s).
- Remove the plant by tapping the pot in 2 or 3 places against the table or countertop and turning it upside down into your hand. If the roots are tightly wound, gently loosen their ends so they spread out slightly when replanted.
- 3. Add a layer of Earthgro Potting Soil and insert the plant stem or root ball. Fill with potting soil and press lightly around plant. The plant should be at the same soil level as it was originally growing, and there should be about an inch of space from the top of the soil to the lip of the pot.
- Water to thoroughly soak the potting soil, then allow to drain.
- 5. For best results, immediately feed with Miracle-Gro® Plant Food, following package directions.
- 6. Reseal bag with rubber band or twist-tie to prevent potting soil from drying out between uses.

## **GENERAL GROWING TIPS** (See Guide for most accurate conditions)

- Over-watering is the most common problem in growing house and container plants. In general, let the soil dry to touch between waterings. Do not allow plants to sit in drainage water.
- Insufficient lighting is the second most common problem with houseplants. Most plants prefer bright but indirect sunlight. Some plants are more tolerant of low light than others. Refer to specific lighting requirements for each plant species.
- 3. Feed with Miracle-Gro® Plant Food regularly during the active growing seasons (spring, summer, fall). Feed sparingly during winter.
- Most houseplants prefer a humid environment. Do not place plants directly near heating registers or radiators. Humidifiers can enhance plant growth.
- 5. Periodically leach pots to reduce build-up of soluble salts. Place pots in sink and repeatedly (3-4 times) soak and drain the pot with plain water. Repotting frequently can also reduce soluble salts.
