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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply this product directly to the lawn or garden area or non-hard surfaces around the perimeter of your home. Water treated area as directed on this label. Do not water to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. Do not apply to hard surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways and streets where the product is likely to wash off into sewers and waterways. Apply early to prevent infestation. Repeat application is necessary only if there are signs of renewed insect activity. In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area (lawns) within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch). In New York State, do make a single repeat application of this product if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application. Do not allow people or pets to re-enter until dry.

WHERE TO APPLY

Around Home Foundations (Perimeter Treatment)

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply early to prevent infestation. Otherwise, apply at the first sign of insect activity or damage.

HOW TO APPLY

Home Foundation:

- Evenly apply a 2 foot wide band next to the home foundation.
- Re-apply after 3 months if necessary.
- Use 0.5 to 1.0 lb of product for each 500 sq ft (2 ft x 250 ft).
- For best results, treated area should be thoroughly watered
- For 3 month control, apply 2.5 lbs of product for every 625 sq ft. immediately after application.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

- Step 1. Remove cap by rotating counter clockwise.
- Step 4. Flip open spout.
- Step 2. Remove seal from bottle.
- Step 5. While holding bottle parallel to ground shake in a side to side motion to dispense product.
- Step 3. Replace cap by rotating clockwise until tight.
- Step 6. For storage, flip spout closed.

INSTRUCCIONES DE USO

Se considera una violación a la ley federal usar este producto con fines distintos de los indicados en la etiqueta. Aplique este producto directamente al césped o jardín, o a las superficies no impermeables alrededor del perímetro de la vivienda. Riegue el área de tratamiento según se indica en esta etiqueta. No riegue hasta el punto que el agua escurra. No realice aplicaciones cuando llueva. No aplique este producto a superficies impermeables, tales como aceras, caminos de entrada y calles donde pueda escurrirse a alcantarillas o canales. Aplíquelo con tiempo para prevenir infestaciones. Será necesario repetir la aplicación solamente si hay señales de actividad renovada de insectos.

En el estado de Nueva York este producto NO puede ser aplicado en ninguna área de grama o césped (jardín) en un radio de 30 metros de un cuerpo de agua (lago, estanque, río, arroyo, ciénaga, zanja de drenaje). En el estado de Nueva York, repita una sola vez la aplicación de este producto si hay señales de actividad renovada de insectos, pero no antes de dos semanas después de la primera aplicación. No deje que las personas o las mascotas ingresen a las áreas de tratamiento hasta que se hayan secado.

DONDE APLICAR: Alrededor de los cimientos de la casa (tratamiento perimetral).

CUANDO APLICAR: Aplíquelo con tiempo para prevenir las infestaciones. De lo contrario, aplique al primer indicio de actividad o daño de insectos.

CÓMO APLICAR: Cimientos de la casa: Aplique uniformemente una franja de 0.61 metros junto a los cimientos de la casa. Use entre 227 y 454 gramos de producto por cada 46 metros cuadrados (0.61 metros x 76.2 metros). Para un control durante 3 meses, aplique 1.13 kg de producto por cada 58 metros cuadrados. Si fuera necesario, vuelva a aplicar después de 3 meses. Para obtener los mejores resultados, el área tratada debe regarse bien inmediatamente después de la aplicación.

INSTRUCCIONES DE APLICACIÓN

- Paso 1. Quite la tapa girándola en sentido contrario de las manecillas del reloj.
- Paso 4. Abra el pico de la tapa.
- Paso 2. Retire el sello de la botella.
- Paso 5. Agite la botella de lado a lado mientras la sostiene en dirección paralela al suelo para dispensar el producto.
- Paso 3. Vuelva a cerrar la tapa girándola en dirección de las manecillas del reloj hasta que esté apretada.
- Paso 6. Para almacenar, cierre el pico de la tapa.

PRIMEROS AUXILIOS

- Si entra en los ojos:** • Mantenga el ojo abierto y enjuáguelo con agua despacio y con cuidado durante 15 a 20 minutos.
- Si tuviera lentes de contacto, quítelos después de los primeros cinco minutos, luego continúe lavando el ojo.
- Llame a un centro de control de envenenamientos o al médico para obtener recomendaciones de tratamiento.
