STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a dry place in original container.

Disposal: Completely empty container into application (mixer/feeder) equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle and house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated horses but is not effective against existing adult flies. Use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some cases, supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage on the premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control, Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® should be used in conjunction with other good management and sanitation practices.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Feed Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® at the rate of 0.5 lb per 1000 lb of body weight per day. Provide one block per five head of cattle or horses. Place blocks where animals congregate. For optimum fly control, feed blocks continuously. Add an additional block when each block has been one-half consumed. Overconsumption of the Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® may occur if animals are nutrient deficient. All animals should be in healthy condition prior to offering this block. Omit other salt sources from the diet, including salt in feed, minerals containing salt and free-choice salt sources. Start feeding Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity. Co-op Pasture Block with Rabon® may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows; This chemical is not to be used in horses destined for slaughter.
